On the occasion of the match between FC Barcelona and Celtic FC, Barcelona City Council, in cooperation with FC Barcelona, has set up a **leisure area** with a host of entertainment and sports activities to be enjoyed during your stay in the city.

We would like to remind you that both citizens and visitors are expected to observe a strict code of appropriate behaviour.

It is forbidden to drink alcohol or to relieve yourself in the street, and any disruptive or uncivil conduct (rowdiness, vandalism, etc.) is also prohibited. Street vending is also forbidden, and both the seller as well as the buyer can be fined. Any of the above mentioned activities may be subject to fines ranging from 750 to 3000 Euros.

Above all, we hope you have a pleasant stay in Barcelona and that, regardless of who wins, we can enjoy the Game together and without any unpleasant incidents.
